Dual Enrollment Opportunity



Students can earn credit at Alexander and West Central Technical College while in high school.

<u>Criteria for Admissions</u>

- Students must be in 11th or 12th grade <u>&</u> 16 years of age or older.
- Students need to be mature & able to handle the freedom of the college environment.
- Must be in good academic standing, as well as those who demonstrate satisfactory attendance & discipline.
- Successfully completed prerequisite high school courses (at least 1 to 2).
- Meets the WCTC's admissions requirements

<u>How much does it cost?</u>

- Students may apply for the HOPE Grant.
- Dual enrollment students are <u>NOT</u> eligible for additional financial aid while still in high school.
- Must maintain 2.0 GPA in their college courses & complete 67% of courses attempted in order to keep HOPE.
- HOPE Grant covers tuition and fees.
- Students receive a partial book allowance in the beginning & middle of the semester.
- Will have to pay out of pocket costs for some books, and fees such as background checks, exams, etc.

Steps to get started....

Take the COMPASS test, See Ms. Dowda
Student must fill out application.
Apply for the HOPE Grant.
Once accepted, students will replace 2 electives with the dual enrollment courses.

 Transportation may be provided from the AHS or you can provide your own.
